

New Testament (Greek)

ALEIPHO

Matthew 5:17	Put oil on your head
Mark 6:13	Anointing sick people, healing them (James 5:14)
Luke 7:38, 46	Did not anoint Jesus' head (physical, literal)
John 11:2	Identifies Mary as having anointed (physical, literal) feet with perfume
John 12:3	Describes Mary anointing Jesus' feet
James 5:14	The elders are to anoint (physical, literal) sick and pray for healing

MURIDZO

Mark 14:8	Woman anointed Jesus' feet in preparation for burial
-----------	--

EPICHRIO

John 9:11	Blind guy describing what Jesus did with the clay (physical, literal)
John 9:6	Jesus applied to clay to the blind guy's eyes (KJV = anointed his eyes)

CHRIO

Acts 4:27	God (the Father) anointed Jesus (refers back to previous verse, "Lord and His anointed.")
Acts 10:38	God anointed Jesus of Nazareth
Heb 1:9	God has anointed the Christ
2 Cor 1:21	God has anointed us

ENCHRIO

Rev 3:18	Salve to rub in the eyes
----------	--------------------------

Chrisma

1 John 2:20	We have an anointing
1 John 2:27	We received an anointing

Old Testament (Greek Translation) – Just a few, not exhaustive

CHRIO

1 Sam 10:1	Saul had a flask of oil physically poured on him
Ex 28:41	Priests were rubbed with oil (physically, literally)

CHRISMA

Ex 29:7	Priest had oil (literally, physically) poured on his head
Ex 30:25	Anointing oil is physical and literal
Dan 9:26	The Christ, the anointed one
